ENGLISH LANGUAGE ACTIVITY (see separate document)	<p>Play Activity 5 - Adjectives Wheel (1 between 2)</p> <p>Aim: To broaden students knowledge of adjectives for appearance</p> <p>Give students the first part of the task and ask them in pairs or threes to complete some adjectives for each of the items in the middle of the wheel.</p> <p>You might want to set a time limit on how long they can have to complete the page and tell them you will be awarding points for the most interesting adjectives.</p> <p>Now ask them to feedback (display some of their words) and award points for good (and appropriate) adjectives.</p> <p>Now move on and introduce the equipment for today's craft, ask them to fill in the words onto their blank wheels.</p> <p>Now do the task again this time for the craft supplies you intend to use.</p> <p>Probably just do 3 wheels: CD, acrylic paint,</p>

	<p>screwdriver/scissors.</p> <p>Help them to learn some new and varied adjectives. Perhaps have some in mind to introduce to them.</p> <p>Here are some ideas:</p> <p>CD - shiny, circular, reflective, metallic, bright</p> <p>Acrylic Paint - strong smelling, potent, jet black, touch dry/damp</p> <p>Scissors - sharp, pointy, shiny, sparkly, fragile</p>
Other Information	<p>You may want to have pre-painted the CDs (silvery side) if the paint takes a long time to dry. Or if quick drying you could do English activity whilst it dries. Do a trial run and see what you think!</p> <p>See http://www.instructables.com/id/CD-Art/ for step by step photos and other examples</p>

CRAFT METHOD

- Get the CD with the shiny side facing upwards and paint the acrylic side, make sure that it is a thick layer, so that it becomes easy to scratch the colour later.
- Then leave it to dry. (this might be a good time to do the English activity).
- When the paint has dried draw on your design to the side that is painted.
- Scratch along the outline of the, making sure you don't scratch too hard to ruin the shiny bit.
- There will be an example in the suitcase for you to show.
